- Avoid repeating information that you will already provide in your answers throughout the application form (for example, don't repeat your most memorable travel experience story)
- The time limit is 1 minute, kindly do not exceed this limit
- Add your own creative, unique flare to it
- Record your video with adequate light and good sound settings
- Upload your video (preferably in HD) on YouTube or Vimeo as unlisted/private, then copy paste the link into the application form
